GAINES TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NUMBER 115

An ordinance to prohibit disturbances at lawful meetings or gatherings; and to proscribe penalties for violations thereof.

THE GAINES TOWNSHIP BOARD HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Disturbances of Lawful Meetings or Gatherings.

It shall be unlawful for any person to make or excite any disturbance or contention in any tavern, store or grocery, manufacturing establishment or any other business place or in any street, lane, alley, highway, public building, grounds or park, or at any election or other public meeting where citizens are peaceably and lawfully assembled.

Section 2. Penalty.

A person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 90 days.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after publication.

At a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees for the Township of Gaines held on February 3, 2016, Lee Purdy moved for adoption of the foregoing ordinance and Michael Dowler supported the motion.
