FIRE FIGHTER

General Statement of Duties

Performs firefighting tasks involved in combating, extinguishing, and preventing fires. Responds to other emergency and non-emergency calls. Does routine maintenance and custodial work on Fire Department equipment, apparatus, and facilities.

Drives and operates Fire Department vehicles, equipment, and apparatus.

Selects hose nozzle and directs stream of water or chemicals onto fire.

Positions and climbs ladders to upper levels of buildings.

Assists individuals from burning structures.

Utilizes portable two-way base radios to communicate with other fire personnel.

Protects property from water and smoke damage by utilizing waterproof salvage covers.

Performs assigned maintenance and custodial duties on equipment, building, and grounds.
