GAINES TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NUMBER 119

An ordinance to prohibit the breaking and entering of coin boxes; and to proscribe penalties for violations thereof.

THE GAINES TOWNSHIP BOARD HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Prohibited conduct.

No person shall break or enter into any coin-operated or other coin device or depository box or other receptacle established and maintained for the convenience of the public wherein is contained money or other things of value or valuable property therein.

Section 2. Penalty.

A person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than 93 days.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after publication.
