GAINES TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NUMBER 112

An ordinance to prohibit acts which contribute to the delinquency of minors; and to proscribe penalties for violations thereof.

THE GAINES TOWNSHIP BOARD HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor.

No person shall by any act, or by any word, encourage, contribute toward, cause or tend to cause any minor child under the age of 17 years to become neglected or delinquent so as to come or tend to come under the jurisdiction of the family division of the circuit court, whether or not such child shall in fact be adjudicated a ward of the court.

Section 2. Penalty.

A person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 90 days.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after publication.

At a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees for the Township of Gaines held on February 3, 2016, Lee Purdy moved for adoption of the foregoing ordinance and Diane Hyrman supported the motion.
